A motion by Arkley seconded by Janinovich to instruct acting Sec. to obtain a copy of the latest Irrigation Laws of Calif. Motion carried. A motion by Arkley seconded by Janinovich that the President write the First National Bank of Crange Cove informing them that G.C.Bornefeld is now Acting Secretary and that his signature together with the signature of the Fresident be accepted on checks of the Crange Cove Irrigation District. Motion Carried.

A motion by arkley seconded by Zaninovich that the bonds held by the Orange Cove Irrigation District as security for, deposits in the First National Bank of Orange Cove be returned to the bank, in accordance with letter referred to in minutes of meeting of June 20th.1042. Motion carries

declaired and are hereby certified:

That the First Division of said District constituted one precinct for said election and in said precinct, nine votes were given to to said W.W. Arkley for said office and no votes were given in said precinct to any other person.

other Division of said District.

Thereupon, on the motion of Director Geo. Zaninovich, seconded by W.W.Arkley and unanimously carried, the following resolution and order was adopted:

Whereas , it appears from such canvass, and this Board now finds and determines that at said election, W.W. Akkley received the highest number of votes for the office of Directorfrom the First Division of said Crange Cove Irrigation District:

Now, therefore, it is hereby resolved and declared that said W.W. Arkley has been duly elected to the office of Director of Crange Jove Irrigation Dis -trict from the First Division thereof for the four year term commencing

or the first Tuesday of March 1943.
