

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of Orange Cove Irrigation District, January 14, 1970.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. Officers present were Directors Harvey S. Chase, President, D. W. Ketscher, Stanley Beach, Denzil E. Dial, Oscar Orlopp, Attorney Robert Mook, and Secretary-Manager A. J. Vortmann.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of December 10, 1969 were read and approved.

Bills in the total amount of \$24,108.63 were read, approved and ordered paid by the motion of Director Dial, seconded by Director Ketscher. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Beach to deposit \$50,000.00 in a time deposit for six months. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Dial that the deadline for ordering and paying for water for the 1970 season be February 25, 1970 at 5:00 P.M. Applications made after that date will be subject to availability of water and a penalty of 35¢ per acre foot. Motion carried.

The Secretary read a claim for damages dated December 30, 1969 filed by Dwight A. Carlson, Attorney, on behalf of Joseph Thais, Jr. The Secretary reported that this claim had been referred to our insurance broker.

The Secretary read a letter dated December 26, 1969 from E. L. Gipson regarding I.D. 3B/4B culvert across American Avenue at Wakefield now being used as a waste and drain water culvert contrary to the natural drain flow and requested closing of this culvert. The Secretary was instructed to check with Fresno County on this matter.

It was moved by Director Dial, seconded by Director Orlopp to authorize installation of a concrete pipeline to replace damaged I.D. 10 line on Richard McFarlin's property and authorize Robert Mook to institute action to recover costs of replacement from H. A. Collins and/or Richard McFarlin. Motion carried.

Robert Baker and Charles Franklin of Lybrand, Ross Bros. and Montgomery were present to discuss with the Board the scope and cost of the audit of the District's Financial Records. This meeting was brought about by Mr. Franklin's letter to the Board dated December 29, 1969 in which the cost of the audit would increase from a previous \$1,400.00 to between \$3,000.00 and \$4,000.00. After considerable discussion with Mr. Baker and Mr. Franklin regarding the scope and price of audit, the meeting with them concluded.

The meeting was recessed until 2:00 P.M.

The meeting reconvened at 2:00 P.M. with Attorney Robert Mook absent.

It was moved by Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Orlopp that Lybrand, Ross Bros. & Montgomery be authorized to audit the District's financial records for the year 1969 as outlined by Mr. Baker in his discussion with the Board. Upon a roll call the motion was adopted by the following vote:





It was moved by Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Beach to purchase gasoline from Standard Oil Co. effective February 1, 1970 under the Fresno County Price (.1955 ¢) available to all public agencies. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Dial that the open ditch culvert (3B/4B) across American Avenue at Wakefield, now no longer needed, be sealed. Motion carried.


It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Dial that authorization be given to purchase transite pipe as follows:

A discussion was had regarding the filing of "Conflict of Interest Statement". Attorney Robert Mook advised that the State Supreme Court had a case before it on this matter.



It was also reported that landowners had purchased, as of March 10, 1970, 31,506 acre feet of 1970 water.

The Secretary read a letter dated March 6, 1970 from Phillip V. Sanchez, Fresno County, regarding elections, and a letter from Robert Mook dated February 25, 1970 regarding a complaint filed against Delano-Earlimart Irrigation District in connection with excess lands.


It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Ketscher to pay \$20.00 to the Central Valley East Side Project Association as per assessment. Motion carried.



The Secretary read a letter dated October 16, 1970 from Bear Mountain Group requesting inclusion of property into the district. No action taken.




