Further discussions were had regarding the proposed inclusion policy.

It was moved by Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Dial that Robert Moock be authorized to prepare a draft of a consent to annexation for presentation to the Board on January 12, 1972. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Beach that the meeting be adjourned until Wednesday, December 22, 1971 at 10:00 A.M. Motion carried.
