It was moved by Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Orlopp to purchase gasoline from Shell Oil Company effective February 1, 1971 under the Fresno County price, 20.10¢ per gallon, available to all public agencies. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Beach, that Robert E. Mook be authorized to request a formal Hearing on Bonadelli filing on Sand Creek and for Mr. Mook to attend and represent Orange Cove Irrigation District at said Hearing. Motion carried.


A discussion was had regarding excess land problem between U.S.B.R. and Mrs. Marian Picher Schroeder.



It was moved by Director Dial, seconded by Director Beach to pay California Reclamation Association dues for 1971 in the amount of \$25.00. Motion carried.



Gentlemen:

The members of the Orange Cove Irrigation District's Committee have conferred in regard to wages, hours and working conditions of District employees. The Committee recommends to the Board of Directors the following proposals concerning wages, hours and working conditions:

1. That the No. 2 Maintenance Man be given a \$25.00 pay increase as an increase in grade.
2. That the Board of Directors adopt a 40-hour work week in a five-day period, if it can be worked out without the hiring of additional employees. As you know, this is only a problem during the irrigation season and there is no question that it could be implemented during the winter months.
3. That the Board of Directors adopt a policy of allowing compensatory time off during the off season for holidays worked during the irrigation season.
4. That the Board of Directors authorize management to investigate the cost and benefits of a pension plan for district employees.
5. That the Board of Directors approve the withholding of income tax if 100% of the employees agree.
6. That the District employees be given a 4.6 cost of living increase in their monthly compensation effective June 1, 1971.

#### Work Rules and Regulations

##### 1. WORK WEEK

The normal work week shall consist of 45 hours.

Ditchtenders: During the irrigation season the normal work week is as follows:

Monday through Friday 7 AM - 12 1 PM - 4  
Saturday 7 AM - 12

\*\* Sunday 4 hours to check lines

\*\* Ditchtenders are off 2 weekends out of every 5 from noon Saturday until 7 AM Monday as per attached list. Compensatory time is given in off season for Sundays worked.

In addition, Ditchtenders are responsible for the rendition of service in the area they are assigned and to that end are subject to handle emergencies.

During the off season the normal work week is as follows:

Monday through Friday 7 AM - 12 1 PM - 5

**Maintenance Men:**

During irrigation season

Monday through Friday 7 AM - 12 1 PM - 4

Saturday 7 AM - 12

Off Season

Monday through Friday 7 AM - 12 1 PM - 5

**2. PROMOTION and TRANSFER**

When an employee having the greatest continuous employment is, in the opinion of District Management, qualified for a job or a vacancy that occurs, he will be given first consideration.

**3. HOLIDAYS**

 Independence Day \*  
 Labor Day \*  
 Veterans Day \*  
 Thanksgiving Day  
 Christmas Day

When Ditchtenders are required to work on a holiday \* during water season, they are normally finished their work in 1/2 day.

**4. VACATIONS**

2 weeks paid vacation after 1 year  
 3 weeks paid vacation after 10 years  
 4 weeks paid vacation after 20 years

**5. SICK PAY**

Effective May 1, 1970 all employees accumulate one working day of sick leave per month accumulated to a maximum of 90 days.

If an employee reports he is ill, a physician's verification may be required at the District's option.

**6. STATE DISABILITY INSURANCE**

All employees are covered under State Disability Insurance. 1 % of employees wages will be deducted to cover the cost. (effective July 1, 1970)

**7. SOCIAL SECURITY**

All employees are covered by Social Security and deductions from wages will be made as required by law.

**8. MEDICAL and HOSPITAL INSURANCE**

Optional - District pays one half the cost of the individual employees cost. Coverage of employee's dependents can be made at the employee's expense.

In any event, the Committee recommends the following:


1. That the Board of Directors authorize management to investigate the cost and benefits of a pension plan for the employees.

3. That no action be taken concerning the adoption of a seniority policy.






The Secretary read a letter from the U.S.B.R. dated October 27, 1971 regarding excess land appraisals.

The Secretary reported that the 1971 water accounts will be closed and billing be prepared as of December 15, 1971.




A discussion was had regarding the I.D.A. convention in San Diego and the reorganization of the Association by-laws and the election.
