

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of Orange Cove Irrigation District, January 12, 1972.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. Officers present were Directors Harvey S. Chase, President, D. W. Ketscher, Stanley Beach, Denzil E. Dial, Oscar Orlopp, Attorney Robert Mook and Secretary-Manager A. J. Vortmann.

Directors D. W. Ketscher and Stanley Beach were reappointed by the Fresno County Board of Supervisors and took office for four year terms.

Attorney Robert Mook presided as chairman pro-tem for the purpose of electing a President of the Board.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Beach that Harvey S. Chase be nominated for the office of President. Motion carried. It was moved by Director Dial, seconded by Director Ketscher that the nominations for President be closed and that Harvey S. Chase be elected unanimously to that office. Motion carried.

Mr. Chase assumed the chair. It was moved by Director Dial, seconded by Director Ketscher that Oscar Orlopp be nominated for the office of Vice President. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Beach, seconded by Director Dial that nominations for Vice President be closed and that Oscar Orlopp be elected unanimously to that office. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Dial that A. J. Vortmann be appointed Secretary of the Board. Motion carried.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of December 8, 1971 were read and approved.

Bills in the total amount of \$11,364.88 were read, approved and ordered paid by the motion of Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Beach. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Dial, seconded by Director Orlopp to deposit \$75,000.00 in a time deposit to become due June 30, 1972. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Beach, seconded by Director Dial that the President and the Secretary-Manager be authorized to sell the balance of our 1971 water in the amount of 321 A.F. Motion carried.

The Secretary reported that we have a delinquency on current taxes (1971-72) in the amount of \$11,621.25 or 14.5%.



The Secretary read a letter from Attorney Robert Mook dated February 1, 1972 regarding "Spheres of Influence".

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Ketscher that A. J. Vortmann be authorized to attend the Tulare County LAFCO hearing on "Spheres of Influence" on February 16, 1972 and represent the district. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Beach, seconded by Director Ketscher to purchase gasoline from firm which is awarded the low bid under Fresno County effective March 1, 1972 which is available to all public agencies. Motion carried.

The Secretary reported on a letter dated January 24, 1972 from Public Employees' Retirement System that stated in effect that it is possible we might be in violation of the Wage-Price Freeze and it would be necessary to get a ruling from the Office of Economic Stabilization Program and it would be necessary to receive a favorable ruling before they would furnish any further information. A form is being prepared to request this ruling from the Economics Stabilization Program.

The Board proceeded with its discussion of the proposed inclusions.

The meeting was recessed until 2:30 P.M.

The meeting reconvened at 2:30 P.M. with Attorney Mook absent.

Further discussion was had regarding the proposed inclusions.

It was moved by Director Dial, seconded by Director Beach that the Secretary prepare a reconstructed inclusion priority list. Motion carried.





Bills in the total amount of \$58,495.20 were read, approved and ordered paid by the motion of Director Beach, seconded by Director Dial. Motion carried.




A discussion was had regarding the water status. Present indications, due to lack of rainfall, indicate a possible cut in Class I water.

to become due on September 14, 1972. Motion carried.


Fred Bibson, Perry Nelson and Monte Shebelut were present and expressed their views on inclusion of their lands into the district.



The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. Officers present were Directors Harvey S. Chase, President, D. W. Ketscher, Stanley Beach, Denzil E. Dial, Oscar Orlopp, Attorney Robert Mook and Secretary-Manager A. J. Vortmann.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of April 12, 1972 were read and approved.

Bills in the total amount of \$15,147.09 were read, approved and ordered paid by the motion of Director Dial, seconded by Director Beach. Motion carried.

A discussion was had regarding the water status. The Secretary reported that the U.S.B.R. expects to deliver 100% Class I water and 9% Class II. However, it indicates that August is the critical month and it was necessary to split Class II as follows: 6% prior to September and 3% to be delivered after September. This change will not affect our Class I schedule.

Mr. Bob Robesky was present and discussed with the Board the problem of leaks and blow outs on I.D. LAE line located on the N side of his property. The board instructed the Superintendent to obtain prices and specifications of 18" Transite pipe and Plastic pipe and to check other possible methods to alleviate this situation.

The Secretary read a letter from I.D.A. regarding opposition to Proposition No. 9 on the ballot on the June 6, 1972 election.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Ketscher to issue the I.D.A. press release in opposition to Proposition No. 9 to local newspapers. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Dial that the hour being 11:00 A.M. the time for acceptance of bids for two 1/2 ton pickup trucks be closed. Motion carried.

The District's Employee Relations Committee, absent Fred Morgan, met with Larry Null of the Carpenters Union on May 1, 1972. At this meeting, Mr. Null stated that the employees had three requests:

- 3. A 40-hour work week.




Larry W. Null, Executive Secretary of the Sequoia District Council of Carpenters was present and spoke to the Board regarding the employees' request for a pension plan.



Bills in the total amount of \$9,685.50 were read, approved and ordered paid by the motion of Director Dial, seconded by Director Beach. Motion carried.



Mr. William Wright of Prudential Insurance Co. presented two proposed pension plans to the Board. No action taken.


