It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Beach to issue a call for bids for a 4 door Sedan to be opened Wednesday, February 14, 1973 at 11:00 a.m. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Beach, seconded by Director Dial that management be authorized to install water service to D. W. Ketscher's land in I.D. 1A which is located NE of the Railroad R/W in Section 17-14-24 (Lot 43 Wahtoke Colony). Said service to be installed by using the most economical method.







Hickel, et al., Civil No. 69-124-Murray, entered a judgment determining that the residency requirements of Section 5 of the 1902 Act (43 U.S.C. 431) are still effective and enforceable. Section 5 provides in pertinent part as follows:

No right to the use of water for land in private ownership.....shall be made to any landowner unless he be an actual bona fide resident on such land, or occupant thereof, residing in the neighborhood of said land

Although this case has not been finally resolved the outcome could affect the eligibility of the land to receive Project water. It is for this reason that we believe it advisable to inform not only parties to any sale or proposed sale, but also all your constituents about the case in order to minimize the effects if this decision should be upheld.



Minutes of the previous regular meeting of March 14, 1973 were read and approved.

Director D. W. Ketscher arrives.

Bills in the total amount of \$16,622.62 were read, approved and ordered paid by the motion of Director Dial, seconded by Director Beach. Motion carried.

A discussion was had regarding the water status. The Secretary was instructed to attempt to locate a market for surplus 1973 water in the amount of up to 6,000-8,000 Acre Feet.

Mr. Gillette was present and discussed with the Board his request for inclusion of his lands lying E of Orange Cove Irrigation District that could be served by Improvement District No. 6.

The Secretary-Manager was instructed to install an outlet valve in Improvement District No. 6 line adjacent to Joe Ishii #3 Turn Out Structure so that it would be possible for Mr. Gillette to install and connect up a service on temporary basis without disrupting water run in Improvement District No. 6.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Dial that letter of transmittal to accompany the U.S.B.R. letter regarding Residency Requirement be approved and letters to be mailed to all landowners, (See attached letters). Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Dial to send \$750.00 for assistance to A.C.W.A. in their effort to eliminate the Residency Requirement of Reclamation Law. Motion carried.

Gentlemen:

The District's Employee Relations Committee without Fred Morgan met with Larry Null of the Carpenters' Union at 10:30 A.M. on April 9, 1973. Mr. Null reiterated the demands set forth in his letter of March 6, 1973, except that he did not mention the fourth demand, i.e., a Seniority Plan. He discussed with us the following three items:

1. A pension plan;
2. The \$150.00 per month increase in compensation; and
3. The 40-hour week.

The Committee has covered items 1 and 3 in previous years' recommendations and it appears that it would not be possible to go to a 40-hour week without increasing the number of employees. The Committee feels very strongly that the principal concern of the employees is the pension plan, and that it would be in the best interest of the District to adopt some sort of a pension plan, even if it includes limited benefits for the older employees. If you do not intend to adopt a

pension plan, then the Committee feels that it would be well to inform the employees of this feeling at this time.

As far as the increase in compensation is concerned, it would appear to the Committee that the increase in the cost of living justifies an increase in compensation in the range of \$30.00 to \$50.00 per month.


