

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of Orange Cove Irrigation District, January 14, 1976.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. Officers present were Directors Harvey S. Chase, President, D. W. Ketscher, Stanley Beach, Norman Veeh, Oscar Orlopp, Attorney Robert Mook and Secretary-Manager A. J. Vortmann.

Directors D. W. Ketscher, Stanley Beach and Norman Veeh were reappointed by the Fresno County Board of Supervisors and took office for four year terms.

Attorney Robert Mook presided as chairman pro-tem for the purpose of electing a president of the Board. It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Veeh that Harvey S. Chase be nominated for the office of president. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Beach that the nomination be closed and that Harvey S. Chase be un-animously elected to the office of president. Motion carried.

Director Chase assumed the chair. It was moved by Director Beach, seconded by Director Veeh that Oscar Orlopp be nominated for the office of vice president and that he be unanimously elected. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Beach that A. J. Vortmann be appointed Secretary for the next two years. Motion carried.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of December 10, 1975 were read and approved.

Bills in the total amount of \$15,160.84 were read, approved and ordered paid by the motion of Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Ketscher. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Beach to deposit \$100,000.00 in a time deposit for one year. Motion carried.

The Secretary read letters from Robert Mook dated December 22, 1975 re: A.C.W.A. Conflict of Interest, January 5, 1976 re: Amicus Curiae Briefs, and January 6, 1976 re: Vacancies in Offices.





Minutes of the previous regular meeting of February 11, 1976 were read and approved.

Bills in the total amount of \$14,807.11 were read, approved and ordered paid by the motion of Director Ketscher, seconded by Director Orlopp. Motion carried.

It was moved by Director Veeh, seconded by Director Beach that \$150,000.00 be placed in Time Deposits to mature as follows:

The Secretary reported that we had received water orders for the 1976 season as follows.

A check of the orders indicates many landowners increasing their orders over 1975 use by approximately 50%. The Secretary reported that based on this fact and that we receive our total contractual amount of water, we would be able to take care of all the water needs for the season.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Beach that the policy for 1976 water deliveries be as follows:

The District will accept request for deliveries to all persons who ordered water and deliveries will be made within the District's monthly schedules.

In the event the District's monthly schedule is unable to cover the demand, "Secondary Water" orders and "Late Water" orders will be discontinued.

The Secretary will report each month to the Board on the situation.

It was moved by Director Orlopp, seconded by Director Veeh to authorize purchase of a mobil truck radio for the price of \$550.00. Motion carried.



A discussion was had regarding an agreement to cover the operations of Jensen Avenue line to outsiders.







Mr. Burtleson (representing Gowan Growers) requested a supply of water as a hardship case.

The Secretary advised that he had received a letter dated May 31, 1976 along with a check requesting 100 A.F. of 1976 water. No application was filed. The Secretary reported there was no extra water available to supply this request.

D. W. Ketscher requested that the District allow Cross Valley Water to be transferred to O.C.I.D. and be delivered to the individual who arranges the transfer.

It was moved by Director Beach, seconded by Director Veeh that Cross Valley and/or C.V.P. water from other districts may be transferred to Orange Cove I.D. for delivery to individuals in our district who arrange transfer of water for the year ending November 15, 1976, and with the approval of the U.S.B.R.
